


Yamanashi Prefectural Board of Education Organization Chart (As of April 1, 2023)



Education Spending (BOE) Breakdown







Trends in School Enrollment(National/Public/Private Schools) (As of Every First of May)




Trends in Percentage of Students Matriculating to Higher Levels of Education(National/Public/Private Schools)




Number and Percentage of the Distribution of High School Students by Type of Course(Public/Private Schools) (As of May 1, 2023)


Enrollment of Children with Disabilities (National/Public Schools) (As of May 1, 2023)



Career Option Taken by Graduates (National/Public/Private Schools) (Graduated in March 2023)




Age Distribution of Teachers (Public School) (As of May 1, 2023)


School Lunch Implementation Status (Public School) (As of May 1, 2021)




