



Yamanashi Prefectural Board of Education Organization Chart (As of April 1, 2024)




Breakdown of the Prefectural Budget and Education Expenditure (2024 Fiscal Year)




Education Expenditure per Child (Public School/Public Funds) (2022 Fiscal year)



Trends in School Enrollment(National/Public/Private Schools) (As of Every First of May)





Trends in Percentage of Students Matriculating to Higher Levels of Education(National/Public/Private Schools)

Enrollment of Children with Disabilities (National/Public Schools) (As of May 1, 2024)






Age Distribution of Teachers (Public School) (As of May 1, 2024)




Trends in the Number of Assistant Language Teachers (under the JET Programme) (As of Nov 1.2024)



School Lunch Implementation Status (Public School) (As of May 1, 2023)






