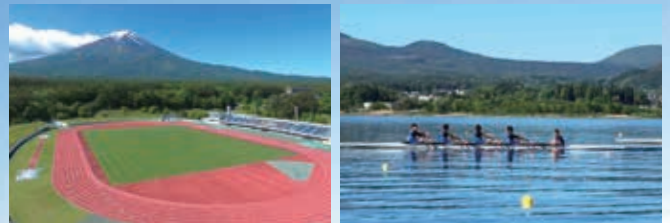

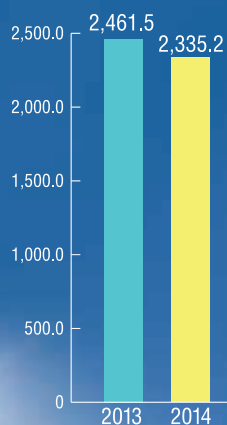

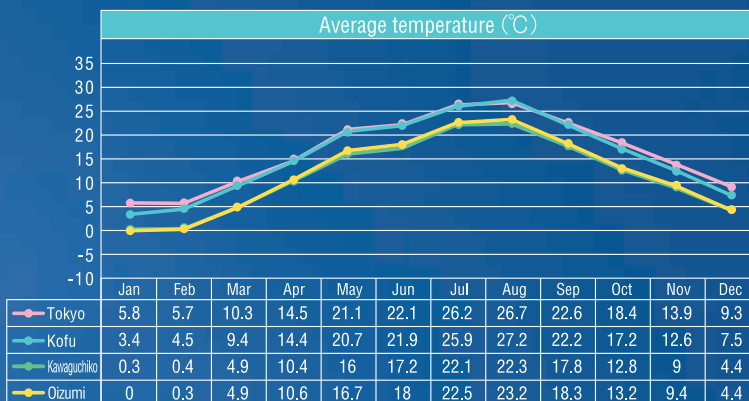
## Point [Long daylight hours]

While Kofu is same as Tokyo, Oizumi and Kawaguchiko have cooler climates.



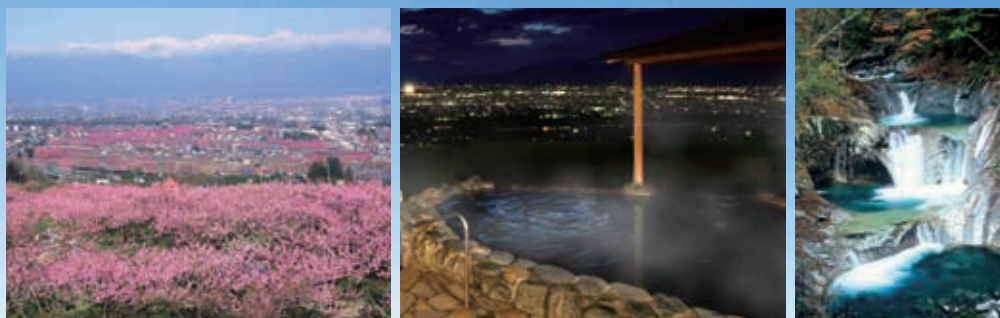
## Point [Delicious food, high quality water]
